Dear Comrade,

Next meeting of UFBU.

We heard that the next meeting of UFBU will take place on 16th August, 2015. We shall consider it a favour if you kindly take necessary initiative so that the issues of retirees can find a place in the agenda items.

The issues, though you are well aware of, are once again harped upon for your ready reference :

1) **Revision of Family Pension**

As IBA is sympathetic to the issue as per views expressed in the record note, why are they not coming out with a cost analysis at an early date and share the same with us in a transparent manner?

2) **100% DA Neutralisation to pre-November, 2002 retirees**

IBA is expressing its humanitarian attitude towards the issue as per assertions in the record note. Why are they not coming out with analysis of cost and share the same with us for examination at our end? Same is the position with the issue of upgrading basic pension at common uniform index of 4400 points.

3) **Our participation in talks :**

Kindly raise this important issue at UFBU meeting also. Let IBA be persuaded to call the retiree organisations at a very early date. Till IBA agrees to the suggestions, the representatives of the retiree organisations may be invited in the meetings of UFBU.

We know that you are awfully busy with different issues and assignments. Still we take the liberty of encroaching upon your time as you are the person who had openly come out by recording the view points of AIBOC on the irrational and illegal perceptions of IBA as recorded in the Record Note.
