**Sub : United Bank Retired Officers' Association holds its 7th Triennial General Body Conference
At University Institute Hall, Kolkata on 30th November, 2017

We have pleasure to inform that our affiliate United Bank Retired Officers' Association very successfully organized the above noted conference on the mentioned date and venue. The tastefully decorated hall of the University Institute was almost packed up by 12 noon and more than 500 retired officers coming from different parts of the country attended the conference. The principal highlights are being mentioned hereunder for information of our members :

- The inaugural session was attended among others by Shri Umesh Ray, General Manager (Human Resources) of the Bank, Shri Sanjay Das, Secretary, AIBOC, West Bengal State Committee, and Shri Kaushik Ghosh, General Secretary, United Bank Officers' Association. Shri Ray in his address complemented the retirees for their long and dedicated services to the bank and he wished them sound health and happiness. He also appealed to the retirees to act as an ambassador of the bank and popularize the name and schemes of the bank before various cross sections of society and also to contribute in the area of training up huge number of newly appointed employees and officers of the bank. He informed the house that the pension corpus of the bank was adequate and sound. Shri Sanjay Das, Secretary, AIBOC, W.B. State, thanked the assembly for a huge attendance. He assured that he is a firm believer of the subject that today's serving man is a retiree tomorrow. The interest of both the segments is interwoven with each other. He recounted the contribution of the retired employees and officers to the growth of bank and trade union movement.
